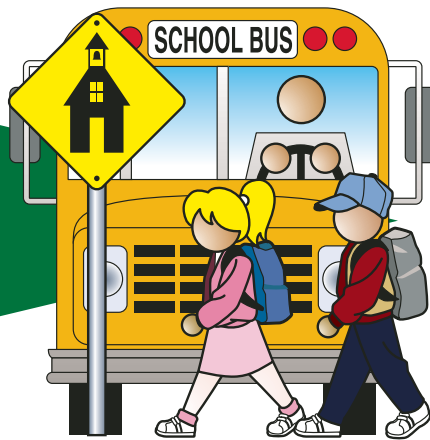


SEND YOUR SCHOOL SOMEONE ELSE'S MONEY



You can give up to \$400 of the money you would pay to Arizona income taxes to your school!

Tax Credit: How does it work?

You can send all your state taxes to the state of Arizona or make a contribution to a public school and receive a State Income Tax Credit for up to \$400 on your state income tax return. ARS 43-1089.01 gives you this opportunity to help the school of your choice.

A tax credit, which is the dollar-for-dollar reduction of your tax liability, is better than a tax deduction, which only reduces your taxable income before taxes are computed.

Here's how it works. Any individual (parent or not) can make a contribution of any amount up to \$200 to the school of his/her choice to help fund extracurricular activities and receive all of the amount up to \$200 back in a tax credit from the state, whether you use a long or short form. The maximum donation per family may not exceed \$200 (**\$400 for married couples filing a joint return**). You don't need to live in the district or have children attending school in the district to take advantage of this tax law. In most instances, a contributor also can deduct the \$200 as a charitable donation on a federal tax return.

Support your school with any amount that you would otherwise be paying to the state of Arizona. Simply complete the form below and return it with your check. The school will provide you with a receipt for tax purposes. Your check should be made payable to a specific school, not a school district.

Each district has specific qualifying programs. If you would like to designate your donation to one of these, contact the district office or the administrative office of the individual school.
